# Wisconsin Women in Higher Education Leadership

## What is WWHEL?

Wisconsin Women in Higher Education Leadership (WWHEL), founded in 1996, is a virtual “wheel” that connects women to networks and opportunities to grow as leaders in higher education. Our goal is to actively contribute to improving the status of women faculty, staff, administrators, and students in Wisconsin two- and four-year campuses, public universities, technical colleges, tribal colleges, and private colleges and universities—which are represented on our Board of Directors. WWHEL is affiliated nationally with the American Council on Education (ACE) through the ACE Women’s Network.

## WWHEL provides women with opportunities to:

- Develop specific skills
- Connect with colleagues who can provide valuable insight into success in various leadership roles
- Identify career development opportunities
- Gain access to state and national resources
- Attend an annual fall state conference and spring chapter events

WWHEL also works with WWHEL chapters and women’s organizations on campuses to support local and regional efforts.

## WWHEL Grants and Awards

WWHEL awards an annual Chapter of the Year and Institutional Representative of the Year at the state conference to those who have advanced the cause of Wisconsin women in higher education. WWHEL also provides professional development grants to women attending local, state, and national leadership programs, provides regional workshops each spring, and offers chapter stipends to member institutions to encourage local leadership activities on campus.
